As a valued Tyre Stewardship Scheme Accredited participant, your store collectively forms part of a growing number of retailers that are demonstrating an allegiance to support sustainable outcomes for end-of-life tyres.

In agreeing to supply data (quantity of waste tyre disposals) on a monthly basis, you are supporting the tracking of waste tyres to ensure your waste is provided to accredited collectors/recyclers in the Scheme.

Step 1

Step 3

Select unit of measure

Once you are logged in, check that the **Unit of Measure** is preset to your accreditation type.

UNITS **TONNES**

- For retailers, the preset will be units. You may toggle between the Unit of Measure if required – the colour will change to light green according to your selection.
- As a retailer, all data entered will be received as either **Units** or **Tonnes**.
I.e.: You are not able to report units for CAR tyres and tonnes for SOLID in the same transaction.

Step 4

Select your input/output supplier/destination

Use the 'Name or ABN' button to **search** and find your accredited TSA partner.

Report for February 2021

You need to add and submit your data before the 15th of the month.

For quick data entry, download a Reporting Template, edit in Excel, save as Text, Tab Separated, and drag-drop back on to this page.

- If your supply chain partner is not accredited with TSA, we would love to know who they are and get them onboard – Notify GetOnBoard@tyrestewardship.org.au.
- Data relating to partners not in The Scheme can be entered against either 'non-accredited' collector or 'Adminretailer' as a consolidated total. (If there are multiple points of collection or disposal).

Step 5

Data entry

Enter the number of tyres you have disposed of using the appropriate category type.
If you report in tonnes use decimal to indicate tonnes (eg 1 tonne = 1.000)

CAR – Standard passenger car / van tyre

LTRV – Light Truck RV (Includes 4WD)

TBS – Truck & Bus Small (17.5" & 19.5")

TBL – Truck & Bus Large (20" & 22.5")

BAL – Baled (generally not applicable to retailers)

SHD – Shred (generally not applicable to retailers)

MC – Motorcycle

SOL – Solid (miscellaneous tyre types such as bobcat, mower etc).

Once data is entered click on **SUBMIT DATA** button located at top of page

SUBMIT DATA

If you have no data to report, leave all data fields empty and click on SUBMIT DATA button.

- This important step confirms you have no data
